Scholarships: All spots already hold a 10% scholarship, resulting in a total fee of 1,475 Euros per

participant.

On April 15th, personal communications will inform the candidates about the result of the selection process, confirming a spot at Action x Change 2018 or a spot in the waitlist.

Motivation to attend the programme, as well as other relevant aspects, will be taken into account during the selection process of the candidates. Criteria also include the selection of candidates that will make up an international, committed, and heterogeneous team of youngsters of different origins, both within Spain and abroad.

Acceptance of offered spots will be by payment of 50% of programme fees (737,5 Euros), which must take place between April 20th and 29th
